Set up an online account

Check in without your ID card

You don't need a Delta Dental ID card when you visit the dentist. Just provide your name, birth date and enrollee ID or

Social Security number. Dependents on your plan will use your information. Prefer to have an ID card? Simply log in to your account to view or print your card.

Understand common dental terms

- **Annual maximum:** The maximum dollar amount Delta Dental will pay toward the cost of dental care within a specific benefit period
- **Deductible:** The amount you pay for covered dental services before Delta Dental begins to pay
- **Coinsurance:** The percentage of dental care expenses you pay after your deductible, if applicable
- **Pre-treatment estimate:** The estimated cost of a recommended dental treatment

¹ You can still visit any licensed dentist, but your out-of-pocket costs may be higher if you choose a non-PPO dentist. Network dentists are paid contracted fees.

² You are responsible for any applicable deductibles, coinsurance, amounts over annual or lifetime maximums and charges for non-covered services. Out-of-network dentists may bill the difference between their usual fee and Delta Dental's maximum contract allowance.

In this incentive plan, Delta Dental pays 70% of the PPO contract allowance for major services during the first year of eligibility. The coinsurance percentage will increase by 10% each year (to a maximum of 100%) for each enrollee if that person visits the dentist at least once during the year. If an enrollee does not use the plan during the calendar year, the percentage remains at the level attained the previous year. If an enrollee becomes ineligible for benefits and later regains eligibility, the percentage will drop back to 70%.
