Incident Type: Stalking and Threatening behavior.

Details:

Starting in the Fall 2025 semester, the subject depicted below sent multiple electronic communications to district employees containing offensive language and veiled threats. On January 12th, 2026, the subject continued this pattern of behavior which resulted in a Notice of Withdrawal of Consent (626 Notice) to remain on either campus for a period of 14 days (Order currently expires 1/26/26). On January 13, 2026, the subject escalated his behavior by re-contacting district employees with more specific threatening communications. This on-going behavior has caused safety concerns and substantial emotional distress.
