Instructions for Faculty & Staff: Upon reaching the evacuation area, one or more faculty members should assign their students to a colleague and use this form to gather the evacuation site head count (column 1,2,3 & 4). Return the form to any emergency response team member wearing a vest. Fill in columns 5 & 6 only as needed.

Faculty & Staff please offer guidance to students and remain on campus until released by a response team member

- ✓ Stay off telephones unless you are reporting a life threatening emergency
- ✓ Do not re-enter the campus until the Safety Team tells you it is safe
- ✓ No moving vehicles in parking lots during an evacuation!

Instructions:

1. Faculty member who is assisting with the head count...**Fill out this form** and turn it in to the Check In station.
 - **Print** the building and room # and the number of people who are with each faculty/staff member right now. Include the name of the faculty/staff member.
 - **Send any people who need medical treatment to the Medical Station near Check In**
 - List name and the location last seen for missing or trapped people
 - List any hazards observed (smell smoke/gas, fire, broken water lines)
 - Make this form work for you. Write as much information as is needed to clearly convey the message.
- ✓ Be aware of **signs of shock** (pale, decreased mental status, shivering or sweating, sudden aggression)
 - Lie the person down
 - Control body temperature
 - Don't give them anything to eat or drink
 - Request medical assistance
