

## Details:

On 10/19/22 the District Police received four different suspicious person calls over several hours. An investigation determined all four calls involved the same unidentified person **pictured below**. The 1st and 2<sup>nd</sup> calls were from a WVC Staff member who reported the subject acting suspicious in the Student Services Center (SSC). The 3rd call was from a female student who reported being followed by the subject from the main campus to her vehicle in Parking Lot 5. The 4th call was from a female student who reported being followed by the subject from the VTA bus stop near Parking Lot 3 to interior of the main campus. The subject did not make any verbal threats or make physical contact with any of the reporting parties. The subject may be homeless and a non-student.
